## Services that LVA Provides to Support its Mission


#### Abstract

Students: LVA provides free literacy services to over 500 adults a year who need instruction in


 Adult Basic Education (ABE) and English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL).Tutors: LVA trains over 34 volunteers a year and provides professional development programs for tutors, teachers, and support staff. These programs train participants to utilize instructional strategies and techniques for low, intermediate, and high-level adult students.

LVA family: $\quad$ The LVA family is comprised of 9 board members, 5 part-time administrative staff, 5 trainers ( 1 master trainer), and 1 administrative volunteer serving in Passaic and Essex Counties offices.

Finances: Our current yearly budget is $\$ 375,500$ (WIA Title II federal grant) and $\$ 138,00$ (others) of which $90 \%$ is utilized for direct services and $10 \%$ for materials, supplies, and operational costs. Other funding sources: Tutors and Students' fees, donations, private contracts, and fundraising activities.
